Jan Ramberg

It is with sadness that Karl Gombrii has notified me that one of Sweden's leading maritime lawyers, Jan Ramberg, passed away on 28th January this year.

Jan Ramberg was an Honorary Vice-President of the CMI, a Titulary Member of the CMI, Vice-President and Secretary-General of the CMI as well as being a past president of the Swedish Maritime Law Association. Over many years he attended a number of CMI events.

He graduated in 1955 from Uppsala University and obtained his LL.D. from Stockholm University in 1970. He worked as a Civil Law Professor from 1970 to 1997 as well as being a practising lawyer and partner in the law office of Johan Ramberg, later Vinge & Ramberg, in Gothenburg and served on the boards of a number of corporations. He worked on a number of revisions of the Inco terms for the International Chamber of Commerce, and served as a Vice-President of that organisation. He was the author of many academic books on maritime, trade and transport law.

The CMI family sends its commiserations to Jan Ramberg's family and the Swedish Maritime Law Association that has lost a towering figure.
