Dear Friends and Colleagues,

It is with profound regret and sadness that I have to pass on to you that a beloved member of the CMI family, James (Jim) F. Moseley, Sr. of the United States, passed away in Jacksonville, Florida on 28 March 2022, at the age of 85. Jim was a Past President of the Maritime Law Association of the United States, a Past President of the Jacksonville Bar Association, a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, a Titulary Member of the CMI, and practiced maritime law for over 50 years.

Attached is the 25 April 2022 letter from David J. Farrell, Jr., the President of the Maritime Law Association of the United States, outlining Jim's illustrious career as a maritime lawyer, and providing a link to the obituary which may be viewed on the MLAUS' website.

Jim graduated from The Citadel, The Military College of South Carolina in 1958, and the University of Florida School of Law in 1961. He was commissioned as an officer in the United States Army Reserve in 1958, and served on active duty from 1961 to 1963, attaining the rank of Captain. Thereafter, he entered private practice and was a founding member of Moseley, Prichard Parrish Knight & Jones, a preeminent maritime law firm in Jacksonville, Florida.

Jim published numerous articles on the subjects of maritime and admiralty law, railroad labor litigation, insurance coverage, and civil practice. He was a valued leader, mentor and generous friend to many, the consummate southern gentleman, and always had a ready smile and a kind word for everyone. Jim faithfully represented the Maritime Law Association of the United States at numerous CMI conferences, colloquia and assemblies over the years, and his participation at these meetings will very much be missed by his friends and colleagues.
