

UPDATE OF ACTIVITIES OF THE SPANISH MARITIME LAW ASSOCIATION (AEDM/SMLA)


1.- New Executive Committee of the AEDM


At the same time, we are doing our best efforts to share with the CMI members our activities via the CMI's LinkedIn, as requested.
