FRANCESCO BERLINGIERI PRIZE 2025

IL DIRITTO MARITTIMO[®] invites submissions for the Francesco Berlingieri Prize 2025, to be awarded to an original unpublished Essay on a topic relating to Maritime Law.

Candidates wishing to submit an Essay are to apply to IL DIRITTO MARITTIMO[®], marlaw@dirmar.com. Thereafter, they will receive an Enrollment Form, to be returned duly completed by 15 January 2025. They are to be 35 years of age or younger on that date.

Candidates will then be provided with an Identification Code. Their Essay, of a length between 7.500 and 20.000 words, including foot notes but excluding the summary, may be written in Italian or English and should be compliant with the attached Editorial Criteria.


Essays must be submitted in electronic format, anonymously, marked only by the Identification Code, without the name or other personal data of the Candidate, under penalty of disqualification.

Essays are to be sent to marlaw@dirmar.com by 15 May 2025 and the winner will be announced within the following three months.

A subsequent event will be organized by IL DIRITTO MARITTIMO[®], when the winner will be invited to make a presentation based upon the contents of her/his Essay.

The current Prize Rules, published on the website of IL DIRITTO MARITTIMO[®] www.dirmar.com and attached herewith for ease of reference, are to be met together, and concur with, the criteria set out above.
